Who Can Enter?

Any registered TBRU attendee can enter the Mr. TBRU contest. (Members of the Dallas Bears are ineligible to enter the contest).

What Does a Contestant Have to Do?

It's easy and doesn't take a lot of time:

- Attend the required TBRU Contestant Meeting on Friday 7pm-7:45pm
- Encourage your fellow TBRU attendees to attend the contest
- Sell TBRU Raffle Tickets during one portion of the Saturday night dinner.
- Attend the Contest
- Work with your fellow contestants in a positive manner

Judged Categories

Contestants will be judged on a 1-10 scale using Olympic style scoring (lowest score and highest score in each category tossed out to produce the composite score). Highest overall score will be the winner of each category. All contestants/finalists will be judged on a separate ballot for the title of Mr. TBRU. All scoring will be monitored by a Tally Master and a member of the Dallas Bears Board of Directors to ensure accuracy and fair practices.

- <u>TBRU Theme Attire</u> TBRU 26 Masquerade the intrigue, mystery and fun of a Venetian style masquerade party. Wear your vision of the TBRU theme attire... what it means to you. You can do almost anything you want from simple to elaborate. Keep the attire legal. Absolutely <u>no</u> weapons! (no matter if they are toys or not)!
- <u>Bears In Underwear</u> Any underwear of your choosing. (Must be Texas legal by no showing of genitals/anus/ass crack. Note: jock straps are not bar/street legal unless they completely cover your anus/butt crack with a minimum of a 1 inch strap to cover said area. The 1 inch strap should be proportionate to your size...complete coverage is required.)
- <u>Image and Personality</u> Title holders become the Ambassadors of TBRU and the Contest. Put your best image and your natural fun-loving personality forward.
 - a. <u>Bear Wear</u> Clothing of your choice that best represents you as a member of the greater Bear Community. (This will be the attire for pictures and awards)
 - b. <u>Fun Question and Answer</u> The Q&A is presented during the Bear Wear category. It is not a serious question so, don't take it too seriously and feel free to respond in a fun manner. You are judged on your interaction with the audience and the manner in which you respond. (You are not judged on the socio-political content of your response).

Finalist Possibility

In the **very rare event** that any category has an extremely large number of contestants, the contest coordinator may institute a finalist elimination based on the TBRU Theme Attire based scores. If a finalist process is going to be implemented the Contestants will be notified at the Contestant Meeting.

Conduct of Contestants, Judges and Contest Team Members

Contestants, Judges and Contest Team Members are expected to treat each other with the utmost dignity and respect at all times. Reminder this is a FUN contest and designed to be fair and equitable and enjoyed by all.

To keep the contest fun, fair and equitable, Judges and Contest Team Members should not fraternize nor participate in sexual activities with Contestants before or during TBRU. Once the contest is over the restriction is lifted. No one can promise, barter or request you to do anything in return for preferential treatment, scores or prizes, et al.

Judges, Contest Team Members and Contestants are expected to come forward immediately if any conflict of interest, personal relationship or other situation that would make the judging process inequitable.
